- 2. Fundraisers Updates
 - a. Duke Football Concessions Approved from Admin. Do we still want to see if it's an option for the final available games?
 - i. Dates:
 - 1. Saturday, September 18
 - 2. Saturday, September 25
 - 3. Saturday, October 9
 - 4. Saturday, November 6
 - 5. Thursday, November 18
 - 6. Saturday, November 27

Admin approval was not official until the beginning of this week. The Board determined that since only three home games remain, we will not participate in this fundraiser this year. However, Mr. C will speak with our contact to express an interest in participation next year.

- b. PeeJays Fresh Fruit
 - i. Will only be online again this year (only home delivery items available)
 - ii. eCommerce Site Opens 10/28/21
 - iii. eCommerce Site Closes 11/28/21

All sales will happen online and items will be directly shipped to the customer.

- c. KMO Coffee
 - i. We buy the bags for \$8, recommended resale value \$15-16
 - 1. Must buy items up front. Bein with 200?
 - ii. Students can take orders or we sell like a "store front." Thoughts?

Decided to not create "order forms" and have students attempt to sell this individually. We will spread information via email, social media, and people interested in purchasing can contact the Band Office (Mr. C). We will also setup a table to sell them at events like our Winter Concert (and potentially Prism).

We will contact the company and ask if we can purchase both whole beans and pre-ground bags. Al will ask about recommended shelf life/freshness for the products. We are working to have the coffee on hand before the Thanksgiving Break to begin offering them for purchase.

 - ii. We need some "Booster Incentives" for the students

Decided to raise goal to \$20,000. Determined the Booster Incentives

All students who raise \$200 will receive beakfast one morning (individually wrapped Duck Doughnuts)

Raise \$500 will received lunch from the Boosters (Chickfila or something similar)

Top three will receive a themed Halloween Prize Bucket

Mr. C will purchase these, cleared to spend no more than \$75

If \$10,000 is raised, the class that earned the most donations will be able to duct tape Mr. C to the wall. If \$15,000, Mr. C will be pied while on the wall. If \$20,000, Mr. C will retake his staff photo for the yearbook wearing a costume.

If rain looks to be an issue, Mr. C will ask to have performance in auditorium at 50% capacity.

Boosters will purchase some cheap clip lights and glow sticks to help students see their music when the sun goes down at the concert.
