- 1. Swing Dance Union Grove United Methodist Church
 - a. Circle the Wagons The Event is Saturday!!

111 tickets have been sold! (tickets were bought mainly by extended families, chorus people, etc.) The goal is for it to be more community-wide in the future.

Mr. C will email everyone that bought tickets, reminding them of the event and all of the details.

Timeline:

8:00 – dessert and coffee.

8:30 – event wrap-up

b. Feeding the volunteers –

Students decided to not buy food because it will eat into the profit. Students can eat

before arriving, and there will also be Crock-pots with shells and cheese. *Parents please bring some crock-pots*.

A question was asked about recording the event. Becky Wilson is considering setting up a camera to record. The Messingers?? (didn't catch the name) will be doing some recording for promotional purposes. Connor Butler and Kyle Wilson offered to do what they did for the fall concert and record the event.

A question was asked about having a donation jar for those interested in making donations to the band program. *All agreed to have a donation jar*. Becky Wilson will make a sign for the jar. The CRHS Band program is a 501(c)3.

2. Concessions Update

- a. We've been having trouble filling spots in these early season basketball games
- i. Be sure if you are planning on working games to pay for NYC Travel you have already signed up for the games.

Mr. C has told the kids that if they do not work their 6 slots, they WILL have to pay for travel for NYC.

Students can donate their slots if they have worked more than their 6 slots already. Let Becky Wilson know which student will receive the donated slots.

Mr. C asked everyone to be thinking about who can help with concessions next year with Becky Wilson leaving.

ii. Parking Concerns

There are a limited number of parking passes, so PLEASE carpool. Passes are reserved for stand manager, assistant stand manager, and parents with the most students in the car.

It was asked if the game last night (November 15th) could count as 2 slots since it went late and was understaffed. Becky Wilson said that Aramark has said that 10-12 volunteers is comfortable, but 8 is doable. Last night there were 11 volunteers, so this game will not count as 2 slots.

Discussion ensued about the possibility of counting 2 slots for the remaining late games on weekdays. There are two more 9pm basketball games during the week. *All agreed to give double credit for these concession slots*.

3. Fruit Sale

Volunteers will be needed when items are delivered - First Week in December. Date TBD.

Approximately \$2,200 worth of fruit was sold, with a profit of approximately \$900. Volunteers will organize the fruit and wait while it is being distributed. Students will do the heavy lifting.

4. Band Apparel Update

The response time was too long for the catalog from Fan Cloth. There will not be an order ready by Christmas. This will be revisited in the spring.

5.Looking ahead to rest of 2017: Hillsborough Christmas Parade, Prism Concerts, Students Registering for District and Jazz Auditions, Winter Concert

December 6 – those registering to audition for All-District MUST play their audition for Mr. C. If the student attends the audition, it will count as a concert review for the 2^{nd} 9 weeks

December 9 – PRISM December 18 – winter concert (Mayor Stevens guest narrator) January 18 – MPA boot camp

February – jazz festivals
