Mr. Cvijanovic has been talking to a couple of parents and there may be a possibility for an audio only option with some pictures and a slideshow. Candace Marles said that she has full video editing capability. She would be willing to help, if no one else can. Mr. Cvijanovic said that there are three other parents that can also help.

Mr. Cvijanovic said that there are possibilities of getting small ensembles together on Fridays, but they are waiting on the proper PPE. Orange High School has used a program that is \$500, plus \$40 per performer for one piece. This would run Wind Ensemble about \$2000 for one piece.

Lisa Dumain said that this sounds fun but does not sound like a good investment.

Mr. Cvijanovic said that the kids want a product and something to work toward, but this is not an expense that could just be accepted. Candace Marles said that there are a lot of amateur or part-time professional musicians who have recently had to figure out how to do this. The Music Director for the band at her church has had to learn some programs, and she is wondering if someone like him could provide the editing capability that is needed, but at a much more reasonable rate. She said that she would be happy to speak with the music director about this.
